2012 VERMONT MAPLE AMBASSADOR CONTEST QUALIFICATIONS, RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Must be 16 years of age and not over 21 by April 27, 2012.
2. Must not be married - nor ever have been prior to entering the contest. Should you marry during the year; the runner up will take over with a percentage of the prize.
3. Applicants shall not have formerly been Vermont Maple King or Queen or Miss Vermont Agriculture. This year's Vermont Maple Ambassador may run for Vermont Young Agriculture Ambassador the following year.
4. Applicants are required to be at the Exhibit Hall in St. Albans on the afternoon of Saturday, April 28th for an interview. During the interview, the judges will be asking you questions about the process of sugaring and seeking your ideas on the future of the maple industry in Vermont. Judges will be observing your appearance, poise and speech delivery. You will also be asked how available you will be during the year. (Do not apply if you will not be able to fulfill the obligations listed below)
5. The Vermont Maple Ambassador and runners-up will be announced at the Maple Banquet held that same evening starting with the Social time at 5:30 and Dinner at 6:00 pm. One free Banquet ticket will be provided for each applicant. We encourage you to bring your family and friends. Attendance at this event is mandatory.
6. The Vermont Maple Festival and the Vermont Maple Sugarmakers' Association will expect you to be available for the required number of events listed below throughout the year. You will be representing the Vermont Maple Industry in promotion, publicity and education.
7. The Vermont Maple Ambassadors will each receive a total of \$2000. The first \$1000 being awarded at the crowning and you are required to be in the Vermont Maple Festival Parade the day following the competition. Below are the mandatory events that you are asked to attend:
 - 1.) Vermont Maplerama held during the summer of 2012
 - 2.) Maple Sugarhouse at the Champlain Valley Fair in Essex Jct. held in September 2012
 - 3.) Big "E" (Eastern States Exposition) held in Springfield, MA in late September 2012
 - 4.) Vermont Farm Show held in January of 2013
 - 5.) Governor's Tree Tapping Ceremony held in March of 2013
 - 6.) Vermont Maple Festival Banquet to crown New Ambassadors in April 2013

We also suggest that you attend as many of the local county fairs as possible to meet new people and promote maple at these functions but they are not mandatory.

The remaining \$1000.00 will be awarded to you after the Farm Show in January 2013 but you will still be required to attend the remaining mandatory events listed above.

If you are invited and attend any additional events or activities, the host organization *may* be responsible for your expenses, which may include an entry ticket, a meal allowance, parking and mileage.

9. All entries must be received no later than April 18, 2012.
