2021 VERMONT MAPLE AMBASSADOR CONTEST QUALIFICATIONS, RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Must be 16 years of age and not over 21 by April 16, 2021.
2. Must not be married - nor ever have been prior to entering the contest. Should you get married during the year; the runner up will take over with a percentage of the prize.
3. Applicants shall not have formerly been Vermont Maple King or Queen or Miss Vermont Agriculture. This year's Vermont Maple Ambassador may run for Vermont Young Agriculture Ambassador the following year.
4. Applicants are required to be available for a zoom interview on Saturday, April 17th. During the interview, the judges will be asking you questions about the process of sugaring and seeking your ideas on the future of the maple industry in Vermont. Judges will be observing your appearance, poise, and speech delivery. The winning Vermont Maple Ambassadors and runners up will be notified later that day. Due to Covid-19 and there not being a Maple Festival in April 2021 there will not be an in-person announcement.
5. The Vermont Maple Festival and the Vermont Maple Sugarmakers' Association will expect you to be available for the required number of events listed below throughout the year. You will be representing the Vermont Maple Industry in promotion, publicity and education.
6. The Vermont Maple Ambassadors will each receive a total of \$2500. The first \$1000 being awarded in April 2021 once the new Maple Ambassadors have been chosen.
7. Below are the mandatory events that you are asked to attend: (Subject to change or being cancelled due to Covid-19)
 - Vermont Maplerama held during the summer of 2021-TBD
 - Maple Sugarhouse at the Champlain Valley Fair in Essex Jct. held in September 2021
 - Big "E" (Eastern States Exposition) held in Springfield, MA in late September 2021 Vermont
 - Maple Cooking Show held in March 2022 (tentative)
 - Governor's Tree Tapping Ceremony held in March of 2022
 - Across The Fence WCAX TV held in March/April 2022
 - Vermont Maple Festival Banquet to crown New Ambassadors in April 2022
8. We also suggest that you attend as many of the local county fairs as possible to meet new people and promote maple at these functions but they are not mandatory. The second \$1000.00 will be awarded to you January 2022 and the final \$500.00 at the Maple Festival in April 2022. You are required to attend the mandatory events listed above.
9. If candidate is under the age of 18 a parent or guardian must sign the application form.
10. All entries must be received no later than April 8, 2021.
